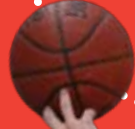

HOW to pack for the best SUMMER EVER!

LUGGAGE TAGS: Regardless of how you are arriving to Kamp (plane, bus or car) we ask that you attach the luggage tags (enclosed in this mailing) to your footlocker and duffle bag. This will help ensure your luggage arrives correctly and quickly.

TRUNKS/FOOTLOCKERS: Packing a footlocker for Kamp has become an art form passed down from generation to

generation. Our packing list located to the right, is all you need to pack, and it all fits, nice and neatly!! In order for us to accommodate your footlocker on the buses and under cabin bunks it must not exceed 15 1/2" in height. The airlines will not accept any baggage more than 62" (total dimensions: L + W + H).

to shop for trunks, duffle bags, name labels for clothing, bunk bed sheets and other Kamp items. Trunks are available in many different styles and colors. They come with a free non-cosmetic lifetime warranty. They also offer a lightweight airline trunk great for those flying to Kamp. All items on this

website meet Kanakuk's requirements.

Special Note: *TrunkOutlet's trunks are available with optional removable wheels. You may purchase these, however we do not recommend their use at Kamp due to the Kamp's terrain. Also, you must remove the wheels before the trunk can be loaded onto the bus, as wheels make packing the bus difficult. In addition to the required trunk, you can pack a small duffle not to exceed 46" total dimensions (L+W+H) – also available from TrunkOutlet.*

REQUIRED: Kamper's wishing to operate personal watercraft at K-2 must have a Boater's Certification Card and a photo I.D.. For more information on getting certified, go to:

KAMPER GROUND TRANSPORTATION GUIDE



Let us help you with your Kampers transportation to Kanakuk Kamps. Use these steps to reserve your seat on one of our Kanakuk chaperoned charter bus excursions.

01 PICK A CITY & DATE *(See the chart on next page.)*

To ride the bus you must have a reservation! If your bus fee has been charged on your account you are confirmed. If you've been confirmed, no further action is needed. Skip to Step 3.

02 MAKE RESERVATION

To request bus transportation go to: www.mykanakuk.com. **Sign-in** and then choose your Kamper and their term. Under "**Transportation Option**" choose "**Charter Bus**". Here you will be able to select "**Transportation (Add/Modify)**". Fill-in the appropriate information and click submit request. You will get a reply/confirmation back within 24-36 hours.

03 LOADING YOUR LUGGAGE

Meet 15 minutes before load time with correct luggage. At the back of this magazine you will find two luggage tags. Regardless of how you are arriving to Kamp (plane, bus or car) we ask that you attach these tags to your footlocker and duffel. This will help ensure your luggage gets to you correctly and quickly. *Note: Read more about our luggage restrictions on page 4. One small carry on bag is allowed. Please no food or drinks on the bus. Bottled water is allowed.*

04 ENJOY KAMP!

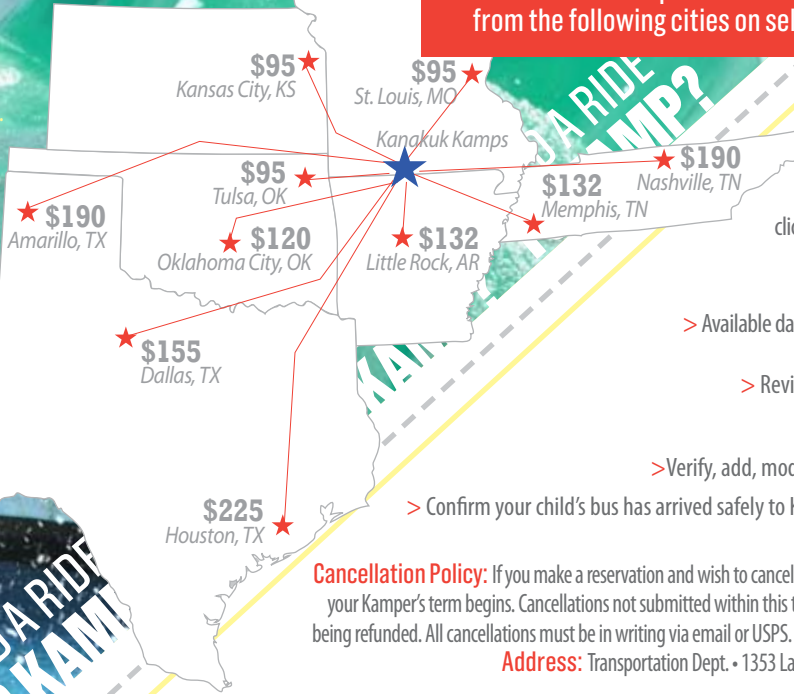
As always, leave cell phones, ipods and all other electronic devices at home. They are not allowed on the buses or at Kamp. This rule will be enforced. Please help us. Buses will have TV/VCR's and we will provide Kamp appropriate movies.

05 CLOSING CEREMONIES

Pick up your child at Closing Ceremonies, a special and very important Kamp event! **Kanakuk Kamps is unable to provide return bus transportation** due to the lack of requests and high cost. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause. (Driving map on page 14.)

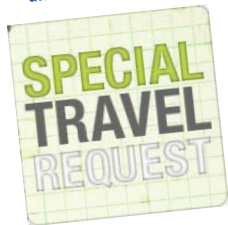
FROM TULSA to KAMP

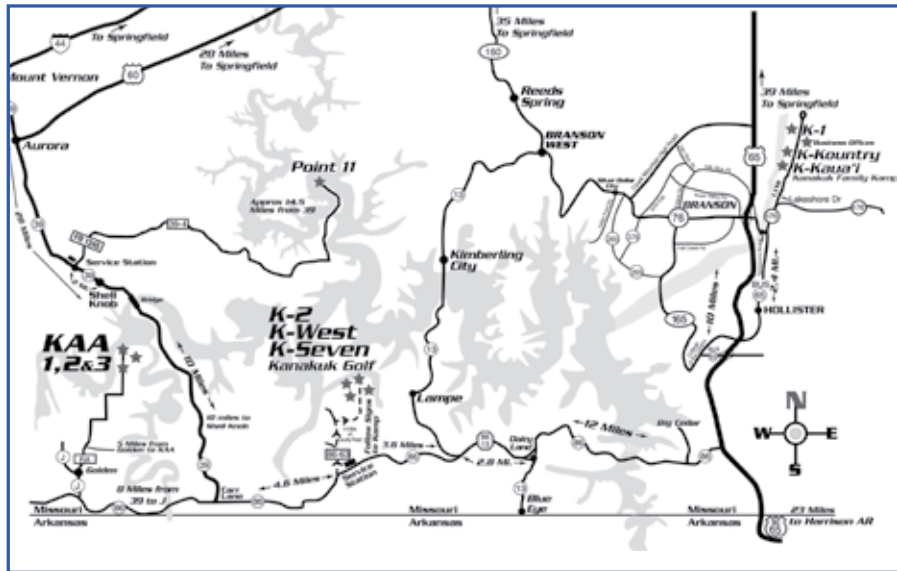
